**49/2018 Accounts –To agree not to request a limited assurance review**

From this year smaller authorities which meet the qualifying criteria are able to certify themselves as exempt from a limited assurance review. (the documentation containing all the relevant information was distributed prior to the meeting and can be found on the parish council's website.) Newton & Stape Parish Council met the qualifying criteria and is therefore able to certify itself as exempt. The parish council could request a limited assurance review at the cost of £200 plus VAT.

Following a discussion on the matter it was **RESOLVED** not to request a review this year provided an occasional review is considered in the future.

The external auditors will continue to select a number of parish councils each year for an extended limited assurance review.
