112	/2018	Considered the application to change the Conditions attached to Planning Approval NYM/2018/0504/FL to allow the pond to be used for angling purposes and the occupancy of the shepherd's huts for up to 56 days in any one calendar year Proposed by Councillor Steve Jackson and Seconded by Councillor Ian Parkin Resolved that the Parish Council has nothing further to add to its comments submitted on 29 November 2018 which: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. sought the decrease in the occupancy of the shepherd's huts from 56 days to 28 days for continuous stays.2. Did not support the use of the fire and wildlife pond for fishing. The Application Site is already small to accommodate, 5 Shepherds Huts, a fire & wildlife pond, a stable block comprising 3 stables (two of which the Applicant has confirmed will not be used to stable horses but will be used to store feed and tack), an access track suitable for visitors' vehicular access and access by a fire tender and a field of 1

		acre for grazing the applicant's own horse. The casting of fishing lines for angling in such a confined and potentially busy space is not compatible with the recreational use of the limited open space around the Shepherds Huts by <i>the</i> other holiday makers which potentially includes children. For these reasons the Parish Council is of the view that to include angling will be an over intensification of the use of this tranquil space.
